DISTRICT WIDE

- All students and staff will wear masks unless eating or able to be stationary & socially distanced
- All PK-12 scheduled assignments will be made with families in mind
- All PK-12 students will learn remotely on Wednesdays
- Most students with disabilities and ELL students will attend in person 4 days a week
- Families will have the option to enroll in 100% remote learning
- All PK-12 students will be held accountable for all assignments
- All teachers will be in the buildings 5 days a week
- No visitors in the building
- Professional development opportunities for teachers and families
- Expand the Districts social emotional plan specific to COVID-19 related support
- Attendance will be taken daily
- No supply sharing in class
- Increase use of online technology
- Routine health screenings required

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- K and 1st grade students will attend in person learning 4 days a week
- PK and 2nd through 5th grade students will attend in person 2 days a week assigned on a Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday rotation; the other two days student will attend remotely
- Minimize student movement
- Recess separated by classrooms
- Special area teachers will go to classrooms
- Meals will be delivered to classrooms

MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Students will attend in person 2 days a week assigned on a Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday rotation ; the other two days student will attend remotely
- Minimize student movement
- Students will stay in one classroom with a few exceptions
- Meals will be delivered to classrooms

HIGH SCHOOL

- Students will attend in person 2 days a week assigned on a Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday rotation; the other two days student will attend remotely
- Student transitions between classes will be minimized
- Students will eat in cafeterias using social distancing recommendations
