## Free Spectrum Internet Service

Beginning March 16<sup>th</sup>, Spectrum is offering free internet access to K-12 and college students that do not currently have Spectrum broadband subscription. This is being offered for 60 days from March 16th. You must not have any bad debt with Spectrum or have had Spectrum broadband internet in the last 30 days. Please call Spectrum at 844-488-8395 and choose the option for new service.

After the free internet offer is over, families will have to call to cancel or they will be billed.

Spectrum does offer Spectrum Internet Assist for qualified households for \$17.99/month.

One or more members of your household must be a recipient of one of the following assistance programs:

- National School Lunch Program (NSLP) (Free and Reduced)
- Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the NSLP
- Supplemental Security Income (for applicants at 65+ only)
